

ORDER IMPOSING CURFEW

WHEREAS the undersigned Andrew T. Dulaney, Mayor of the Town of Tunica, has determined that a civil emergency exists with regard to the observance of Halloween in the Town of Tunica; and

WHEREAS, because of such a situation, it is necessary to declare a curfew on Tuesday, October 31, 2023, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE, a curfew is hereby designated for the entire corporate limits for the Town of Tunica and all persons are prohibited from walking, running, loitering, standing, sitting, lying or motoring upon any alley, street, public property or vacant premises within the corporate limits of the municipality except medical service personnel and persons officially designated to duty with reference to law enforcement within the Town of Tunica beginning at the hour of 7:30 p.m. on October 31, 2023, and continuing until daylight on November 1, 2023.

IN ADDITION, School Street will be blocked for vehicle travel from Hickory Ln. down to Academy Dr., allowing for the safety of children. Cross traffic will be allowed on Beatline Rd. and Academy Dr. School Street will be open for foot travel only. Only low speed vehicles that are registered with the Town of Tunica will be permitted. This will be in effect beginning 4:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. on October 31, 2023.
